As enrolled tribal members and elders of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, we would like to request the following information as stated to be distributed to its members in the tribe's constitution to keep us informed on the tribal activities.


1. Under approved amendment on September 1, 1988, Article I, Section 4 of the Bylaws for the tribe, one of the duties of the Secretary of the Tribal Council is to "submit promptly to . . . Assistant Secretary of Interior copies of all minutes of regular and special minutes of the Tribal Council." Since this is part of the constitution and one of the activities that we are sure you have complied with, we would also like a copy of those submitted minutes as general members of the tribe. We have not received any minutes of the regular or special meetings of the Tribal Council for a couple of years at least.
2. We are also looking for the inclusion in the minutes, a financial report from the Treasurer of the Tribal Council, as stated in Article I, Section 3 of the Bylaws of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, September 1, 1988 approved amendment. It states that he "shall make and preserve a faithful record of such funds and report on all receipts and expenditures and the amount of all funds in his possession or custody, such report being made in writing to the Tribal Council at regular meetings . . . ". We would like be informed about the financial status of the tribe to understand what funds we as a tribe have and how it is being expended.
3. On September 1, 1988, in the Lower Brule Tribal Constitution Amendment II, Article II of the Bylaws-Duties of Members, it states, "It shall be the duty of each

member of the Tribal Council to make reports to the general membership of the Tribe concerning the proceedings of the Tribal council." We call on you and all council members to make those reports to all members and look forward to receiving such reports as stated in the Tribal Constitution


As you are both the Secretary/Treasurer, our request is directed to you. We appreciate your prompt response and look forward to hearing from you. Thank you.
