The dates of attacks are sometimes imprecise given people’s unclear recollections of the precise day that an attack took place.

This information does not include all of those killed during this time period. Human Rights Watch received credible information about additional civilian deaths that we were not able to verify and security prevented visits to some areas affected by fighting.
